




- You buy your tickets. Please bring all original tickets and boarding passes with you to Eurocamp.
- If possible, we will give you the money for the journey at the end of the first week.
- We will transfer the money for your departure to you after the camp,
   when we have all your tickets.
- Air traffic is responsible for around 6% of CO2 emissions. For distances shorter than 1000 km/24 hours, please take the train or bus. We only pay for the flight in exceptional cases.
- For longer distances, you can also fly one way and travel the other by train or bus.

#### **FIRST STEPS**

**Arrival:** Saturday, July 27th between 12 and 23 at Naumburg (Saale) Hbf.

Departure: Saturday, August 10th after 12 from Naumburg (Saale) Hbf.

Check your route on **Rome2Rio** (all means of transport) or **Interrail** (trains).

#### **TRAIN**

Please check your country's website to see if you can buy tickets to Germany.



#### **DEUTSCHE BAHN**



Please download the **DB Navigator**. You can also use it in English.

If you live in Belgium, Denmark, France, the Netherlands, Italy, Croatia, Luxembourg, Austria, Poland, Sweden, Switzerland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Hungary or the Czech Republic, you can buy the <u>Sparpreis Europe</u>.

Please book the Sparpreis Young. If you get sick the day before and can't come, you only have to pay a cancellation fee of 10 euros.

Your ticket must be 2nd class.

We pay a seat reservation (4€) if you sit on the same train for more than 2 hours.



#### INTERRAIL

- We can pay for the Global Pass (4 days within a month).
- You have to arrive and depart directly.
- Stops along the route are possible.
- Traveling with the Interrail ticket must be cheaper than a regular train journey.

If you would like to use this option or would like to find out more about it, please make an appointment with the team directly.

#### **BUSES**



There are various bus routes between Germany and other European countries. Please go to Magdeburg, Halle (Saale), Berlin or Leipzig.

#### ARRIVAL IN BERLIN/MAGDEBURG/HALLE (SAALE)

Magdeburg: RE Halle (Saale) Hbf, change in Halle (Saale) Hbf, RE towards Erfurt Hbf (exit in Naumburg Hbf)

Halle (Saale): RE/RB to Naumburg (Saale) Hbf

#### **AIRPLANE**

The nearest airports are Berlin Brandenburg and Leipzig/Halle. We need your boarding pass for the reimbursement.

**Leipzig/Halle-Naumburg:** S5/S5X Halle (Saale) Hbf, change in Halle (Saale) Hbf, RB towards Saalfeld (Saale) (exit in Naumburg Hbf)
